

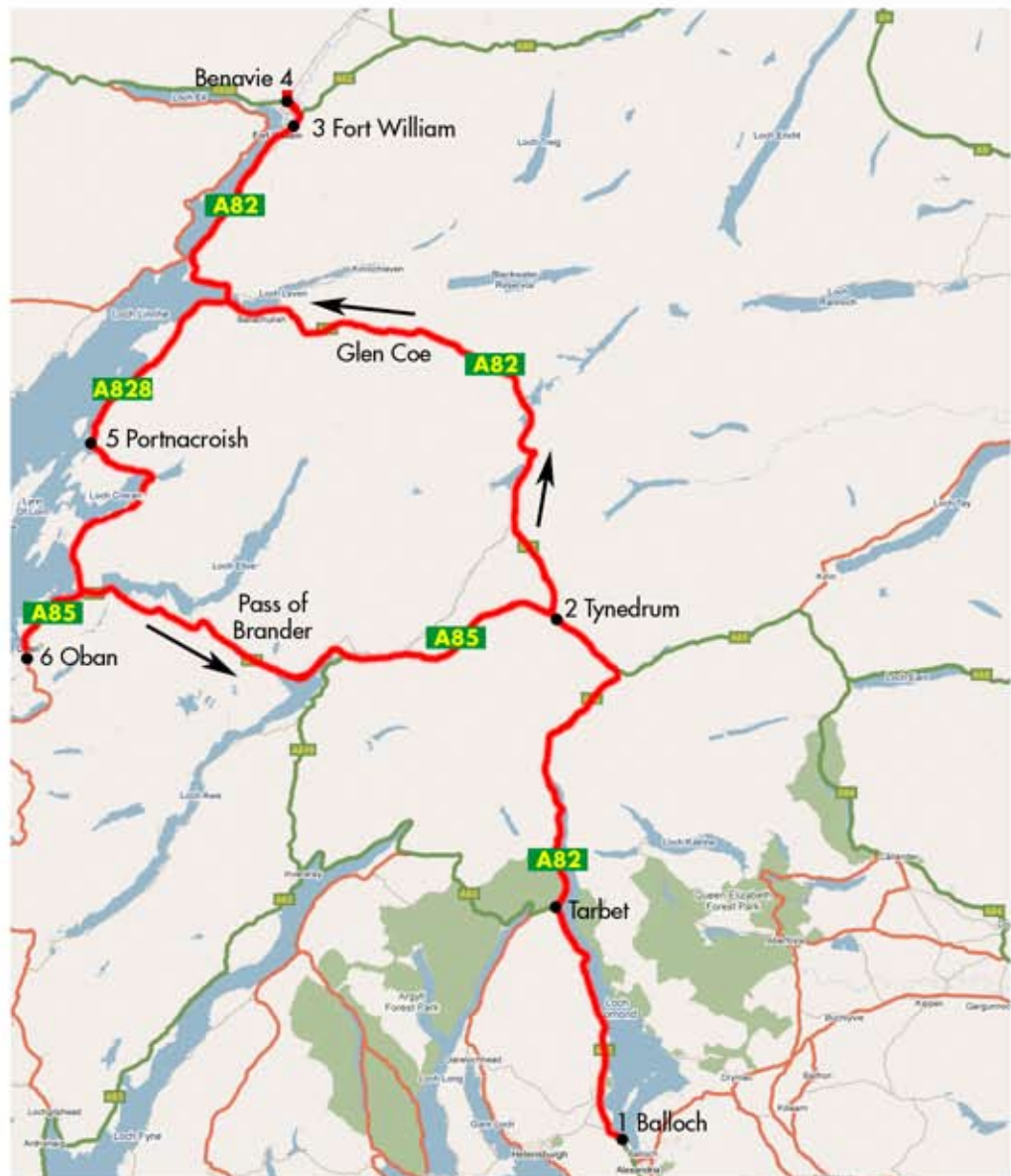
# Fort William

## Trip Summary

A biking rather than a  
sightseeing trip

- 1 Starting at Balloch, take the A82 along Loch Lomond to Tarbet and on to Tynedrum.
- 2 After a brief stop continue northwards on the A82 to Glen Coe, a dramatic valley carved by ice.
- 3 On to Fort William at the foot of Ben Nevis, the highest mountain in the UK.
- 4 After lunch visit Benavie and see Neptune's Staircase at the end of the Caledonian Canal.
- 5 Return south to Oban alongside Loch Linnhe on the A82, A828 and A85. After Portnacroish note Castle Stalker in Loch Laich, a castle in the sea!
- 6 From Oban take the A85 through the Pass of Brander to Lochawe and return via Tynedrum and Tarbet to Balloch.
