

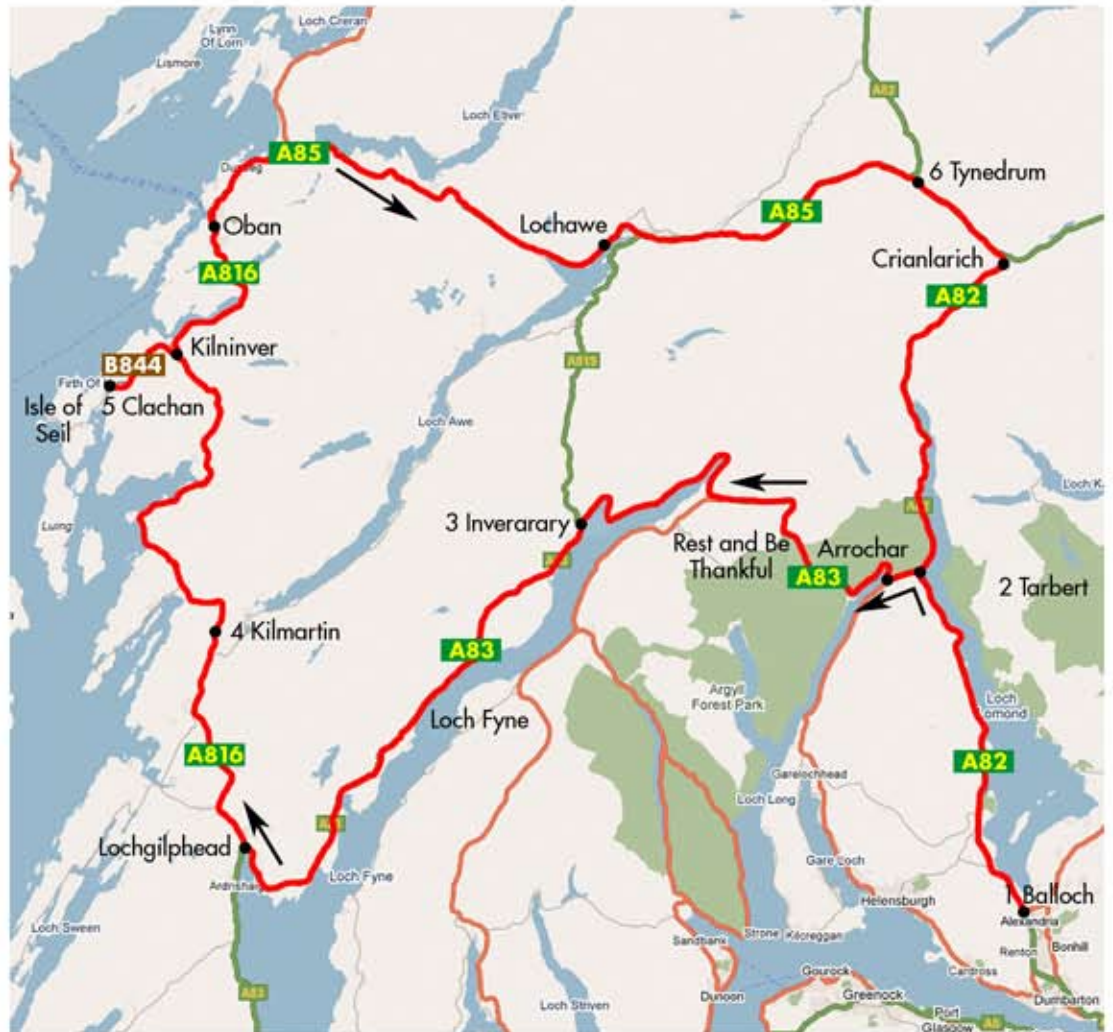
# Kilmartin

184miles/296km



## Trip Summary

- Faster open roads
- Few towns or villages
- Glens and lochs
- Prehistoric monuments
- Coastal views



- 1 Head north from Balloch on the A82 along Lochlomondside to Tarbert.
- 2 Take the A83 and ride through Arrochar and over The Rest and Be Thankful, continue around the head of Loch Fyne with magnificent views towards Inveraray.
- 3 After a brief stop resume your journey along the A83 to Lochgilphead, then follow the A816 into the Kilmartin Glen, an area with one of the richest concentrations of prehistoric monuments and historical sites in Scotland.
- 4 From Kilmartin head north to Kilninver and take a small detour to Clachan via the B844 to cross over to the Isle of Seil using the only "Bridge Across the Atlantic!"
- 5 Retrace your route back to the A816 and then continue through Oban, round to Lochawe and then on to Tynedrum.
- 6 After a much need stop for refreshment, head to Crianlarich and join the A82 to ride along the banks of Loch Lomond through Tarbert and back to Balloch.
