

# Rothesay [Queen of the Clyde Resorts]

153miles/246km



## Trip Summary

- Open roads – fast and slow
- Some single-track roads
- Mountains
- Sea
- Ferry trips
- Few towns or villages



- 1 Starting at Balloch journey north along the A82 to Tarbert, then follow the A83 over the Rest and Be Thankful.
- 2 At Cairndow head along the shores of Loch Fyne to Otter Ferry using the A815, A886 and the B8000 single-track road.
- 3 Continue down the peninsular to Millhouse and then on round to Tighnabruaich.
- 4 After a brief stop ride around the edge of Loch Riddon via the A8003 to Glendaruel and then the A886 to Colintraive.
- 5 Take the very short ferry crossing to the Isle of Bute and follow the A886 through Port Bannatyne to Rothesay.
- 6 After lunch and sight-seeing take the ferry to Wemyss Bay.
- 7 Head to Greenock using the A78 before taking the A8, M8 and M898 to the Erskine Bridge and then back to Balloch on the A82.
