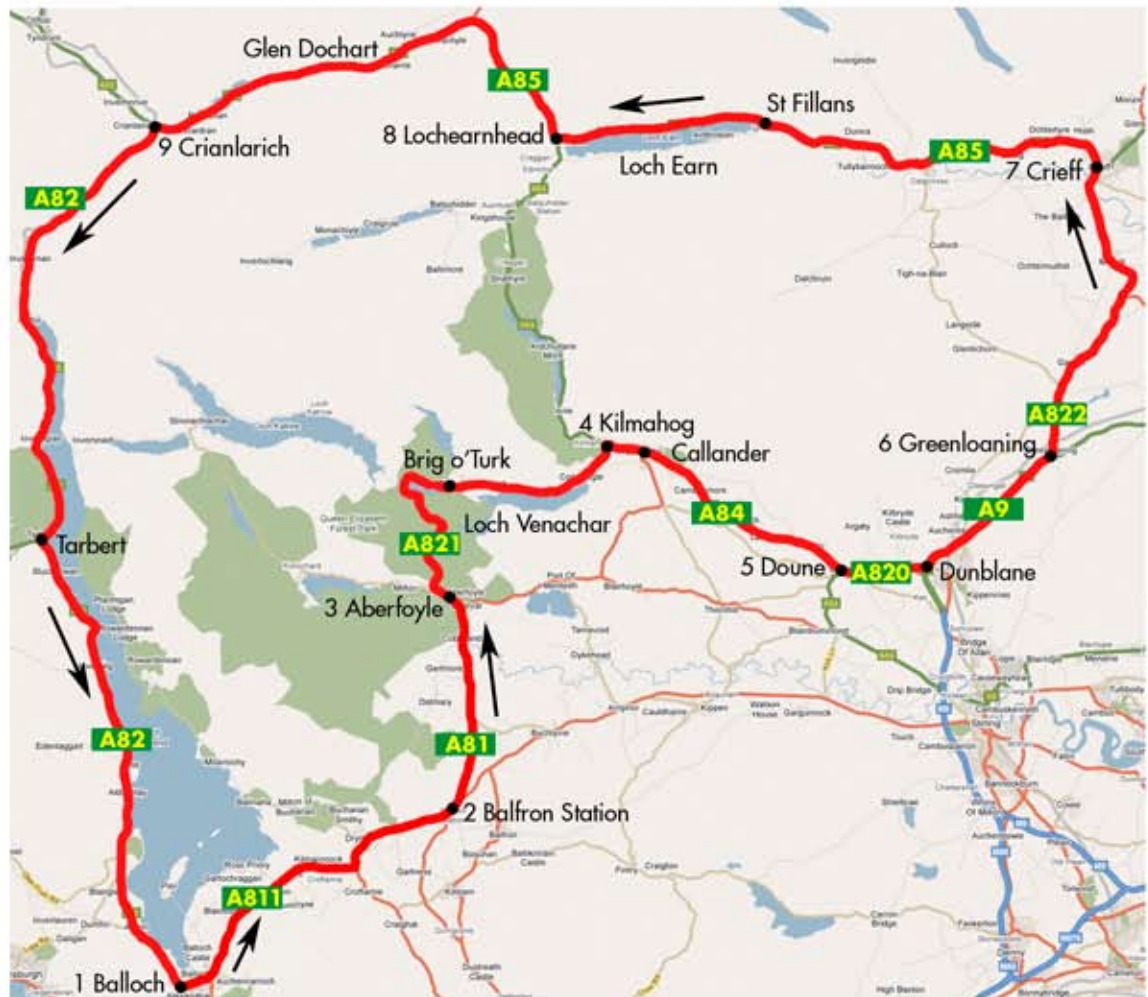
Trip Summary

Open roads – fast and slow

- 1 From Balloch take the A811 around the south shore of Loch Lomond, an area world-famous for its natural beauty.
- 2 On reaching Balfron Station take the A81 to Aberfoyle, a perfect place to stop.
- 3 Enjoy the undulating ride from Aberfoyle along the A821 across the Boundary Fault into the Highlands.
- 4 Turn right at Kilmahog on to the A84 and ride through the tourist town of Callander.
- 5 At Doune take the A820 towards Dunblane before joining the A9 north.
- 6 When you get to Greenloaning follow the A822 to the busy town of Crieff.
- 7 Head west from Crieff along the tree-lined shore of Loch Earn, through St Fillans and on to Lochearnhead.
- 8 Follow the A85 through Glen Dochart past Loch Lubhair to Crianlarich.
- 9 For the final section of this run, take the A82 from Crianlarich to Tarbert and back along the Lochlmondside to Balloch.
